CHAPTER V CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

A. Conclusion

After obtaining the data, the researcher calculated the data. First, the researcher got the pre-test result of mean score of print media which was lower than digital media (55,63 > 53,47). In post-test, the mean score of print media found to be also lower than digital media (86 > 76). From the data, the researcher conclude that there was significant difference using print media and digital media toward students reading comprehension achievement in news item text at MAN 1 Lampung Timur. Besides that, the students understood more reading. So, the students reading comprehension were enhance than before.

Last but not least, the researcher concludes that print media and digital media is efficient in students reading comprehension based on the research findings and discussion.

B. Suggesstion Of The Research

After the research is completed, the researcher would like to recommend the suggestions as a follows:

- 1. Based on the results of data analysis, it was determined that print media and digital media could achieve better students' reading comprehension than before. In this case, to improve students' reading comprehension, teachers are advised to implement two media in learning to read, so that students are more enthusiastic and understand learning to read.
- 2. In an effort to achieve students' reading comprehension, it is suggested that students understand the meaning of reading and students should concentrate on the teacher who explains the material. Students must have a dictionary so they don't find it difficult to investigate and understand new readings. If students bring a dictionary then learning activities can run well.
- 3. This research determines that digital media has a big impact on students reading comprehension. This research can be a reference for developing this research. So that the other researchers can find enormous results related to this problem.
