The subjects were 10 education news in the Jakarta Post Website there are 1 December 2020 – 5 April 2021. The researcher found 111 data inflectional affixes using suffix –d and –ed. There are 54 data of suffix –d and 57 of suffix –ed.


Based on the result of the analysis the researcher found two type of nouns suffix, there are noun suffix –d and noun suffix –ed. There are 25 noun suffix –d and 30 noun suffix –ed. All of the suffixes that have found, the researcher found the similarities and differences. While the differences word suffix –d followed by vowel : [a:] with 2 data, [e] with 38 data, [i:] with 14 data, [o:] with 0 data, [u:] with 0 data. And the similarities of word suffix –ed followed by consonant : [y:] with 4 data, [t:] with 11 data, [w:] with 3 data, [d:] with 10 data, [s:] with 5 data, [n:] with 4 data, [k:] with 4 data, [p:] with 4 data, [l:] with 7 data, [h:] with 3 data, [g:] with 1 data, [c:] 1 data.

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
