CHAPTER V CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

A. Conclusion

In this chapter describes the results of research based on the findings of data analyzed by researcher. The results of this research were the used types of idiom in Westlife song lyrics in their *Spectrum* Album, and the meaning of idiom that have been found.

The researcher found three types og idiom, it is phrasal verb idiom, prepositional verb idiom and partial idiom. In this "Spectrum" Album researcher found 24 idiom, as follow; 6 phrasal verb idiom: by the way, at least, running away, gave it up, look out looking back. 2 prepositional verb idiom: walk away, just the way you are. 16 partial idiom: plenty of fist in the sea, all the boxes that I want ticked, missing you like crazy, you're my blood, make this house a home, like dynamite, like fireflies, love in the dark, bring me the sun, head is broken, arms are open, shining light, clear the air, burning sun, the sun will shine, swallowed up by the darkness.

Whereas, for the meaning researcher find that between conceptual meaning. Affective meaning, and connotative meaning is different. Which the 24 idioms that have been found have three different meanings. But from the meaning of the three are still interconnected and have a meaning that is not much different. Based on the result, idiom is one of the important parts that are not only needed in writing song lyrics, but also in writing poetry, in writing prose or other literary works. The used idiom in writing song lyrics make the lyrics of song more interesting and more meaningful. Knowing the types of idiom and their meaning contained in the lyrics of song is important because it can help reader understand the aim of the literary works it self.

B. Suggestion

In this part state some point that could be used as reference, as follow:

a) For readers who are interested in idiom especially in the scope of literature such as song, poem, novel. This research help the reader to add knowledge about the types of idiom especially phrasal verb idiom,

- prepositional verb idiom and partial idiom, not only the types of idiom but also the meaning idiom in conceptually, affective meaning and connotative meaning.
- b) For students, this research can be useful for students who are learn vocabulary and improve their English skill especially speaking, this research can add information about idiom.
- c) For the next researcher, this study useful for the next researcher which are interested doing in the same topic, that is idiom with theory from Palmer and Leech the next researcher can use other song lyrics or different data such as poem, film, novel and other.
