CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

A. Conclusion

This chapter explains the result of the research based on finding. This research is to find out the conjunction and the dominant conjunction in Abstract Premise Journal. It consists of 9 articles in it. However, it is found that there are 68 conjunctions consist of 14 coordinating conjunction, 1 correlative conjunction and 53 subordinating conjunction. With the total percentage 21% coordinating conjunction, 1% correlative conjunction and 78 % subordinating conjunction.

Based on the result, it can be seen that subordinating conjunction is dominantly used in abstract Premise Journal with the total percentage 78%. It is because the abstracts have a lot of sentences that connect each other by using conjunctions. Furthermore, abstract represents the content of the each article. For that reason, it consists of several complex sentence that need to be connected by using conjunction.

The researcher suggests that the readers should learn and understand each types of conjunction because it is very important to be used in a sentence especially in composing abstract.
